### Quebec Trail Permit:

The procedure for obtaining a trail permit has changed. We no longer have booklets of passes to fill out for you. **ALL permits are only sold online** .

The trail permit can only be purchased by the registered owner of the snowmobile; an account must be created in his/her name. Accepted online payment methods: VISA or Master Card

The transaction is carried out on a secure site and no information related to your credit card will be retained once the transaction is complete.

- Step 1 go to https://fcmq.qc.ca/en/trail-permit/line-trail-permits/
- Step 2 click on "But a trail permit", then create an account
- Step 3 provide year, make, model, plate number & VIN of snowmobile, click "buy permit"
- Step 4 in box asking for club number enter 201 (excellent snowmobile club)
- Step 5 find enhanced sled icon on map below and click on it
- Step 6 pick season, weekly or daily permit
- Step 7 provide credit card information, click purchase
- Step 8 save & print temporary pass for use before permit arrives
- Step 9 receive trail pass (for USA buyers, plan on arrival in 3 weeks)
