Essential Documents and Personal Items

- Drivers License
- Passport
- Credit Cards/ATM Card
- Cell phone/charger
- Spare Check
- Spare Keys
- Cash we recommend having \$100-\$200 Canadian, the best exchange rate will be using your debit card at an ATM once you're in Canada.

- Vehicle, trailer, & sled registrations
- Snowmobile Trail Permit
- Vehicle, trailer, & sled insurance
- Warranty cards for trucks & sleds
- Medical tags or allergy info
- Prescription medication
- Tylenol / Advil
- Spare eyeglasses / contacts
- Earplugs
- Sunglasses

Clothing and Bags





All of our trips **except** the Great Gaspe are saddlebag trips. Everything will be packed and transported via your snowmobile to each night's destination.

Saddlebag: must be durable for various weather conditions. Snowmobile saddlebags, a backpack, or small duffel bag are acceptable. All inside contents must be sealed in airtight plastic bags, such as dry bags or large ziploc bags so that items don't get wet and freeze. Saddlebags may be secured to the sled with bungees, ratchet straps, or tie downs. Please reach out beforehand if you need to borrow bungees from the guide.

Inside Contents:

- multiple pairs of wool or poly socks to layer/rotate throughout the trip, including 2 heavier pairs.
- underwear
- long underwear (fleece or polartec)
- thermal tops for layering
- fleece zip-up/pullover with collar or high neck.
- set of casual shirt/pants to change into after riding.
- toiletries
- indoor shoes/slippers
- additional neck gator to layer on top of balaclava
- beanie/hat for being outside without your helmet
- swim suit
- CPAP machine if applicable

Additional bag with contents NOT going on the snowmobile:

- outdoor boots
- 1-2 sets of warm clothing to change into when the trip ends / for departure home

NOTE!

It can be very COLD in Quebec. Bring appropriate clothing and layers. Please ask any questions regarding what to bring now, because after we begin the trip it is much more difficult to make changes.
